Chairman Crofton called the Public Hearing to order at 5:30 PM

Public Hearing (5:32 PM)

Ruth Williams stated that the millage rate for the proposed budget is 9.001 % less than the rolled-back rate, the rolled-back rate is 3.8084 mills, the millage rate for the 2007-2008 budget as advertised is 3.4656, the total budget is \$48,932,569.00, and the total certified taxable value of real estate for budget purposes is \$4,094,107,188.00 , of which one mill would generate \$4,094,107.00.

Chairman Crofton opened the floor for public comment. There were no comments from the floor.

Mrs. Williams discussed the make up of the total budget including grants and ad valorem amounts, what funds are certain versus what funds are expected and how revenues and expenditures are stated.
