**MINUTES**

**Call to Order 4:35 PM**

**Motion by Sanders, seconded by Putnal, declaring a need for an Emergency Meeting; Motion carried 5-0.**

Chairman Parrish called the Emergency Meeting to order.

Attorney Shuler explained that there is a boat blocking the entrance to the boat ramp located on Patton Drive, and access to that boat ramp will be in high demand especially because of the upcoming holiday weekend. Attorney Shuler discussed the different attempts the County has made to contact the owner, which were all unsuccessful. Attorney Shuler then explained that there is the option of using FWC's process to remove the boat which would take a few weeks but would restrict access to the ramp for that time. Attorney Shuler suggested having County employees remove the boat with due diligence and care and store it at the Sheriff's department.

The Board discussed this matter.

**Motion by Jackel, seconded by Sanders, to accept the recommendation of Attorney Shuler and allow County staff to remove the boat that is blocking the boat ramp on Patton Drive and store it at the Sherriff's impound lot; Motion carried 5-0.**

Chairman Parrish asked Attorney Shuler to look into recapping any expense the County might incur with this action, and would like the Board at sometime in the future to consider a County ordinance for the moving and storing of derelict and abandoned vessels.
