Culvert and Driveway Specifications

A County inspector will visit your property and review the requested location of your driveway. Where a culvert is required, it shall have a minimum length of 30 feet, have 4:1 or 2:1 mitered end, and to be a minimum of 15 inches in diameter unless otherwise specified by the County.

Call the Franklin County Road Department at (850) 670-8640 to inspect your driveway when work has been completed. If it is unacceptable, you will have to correct any deficiencies and call for another inspection. When the driveway connection is approved, the Road Department will sign this permit as approved and forward the permit to the Building Department. If any building permits were obtained, schedule Building Department inspections as indicated on the inspection card.

Prior to a final inspection or issuance of a Certificate of Occupancy by the Building Department, the Road Department will perform a final inspection to ensure that no damage to the roadway, shoulder, swale, or driveway connection has occurred. If any damage has occurred, the driveway connection must be corrected before release of the CO or final Building inspection.

NOTICE

Vehicles must access your property only across the approved driveway connection. Any and all damages, no matter who caused the damage, will be the responsibility of the applicant of the building permit and must be corrected in accordance with Public Works requirements.

Driveway connection permits are required for every project requiring a building permit. Franklin County Ordinance Chapter 5.5-1.

Temporary driveway connections must be removed or replaced with a permanent driveway connection before final inspections from the Road Department and Building Department.
